

Resolution #11-18

RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A MOBILE COMPUTER POLICY FOR THE TOWN BOARD FOR THE TOWN OF GREENVILLE, WI

WHEREAS, the Town will make a mobile computer/tablet available to all Town Board members in June 2018; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Greenville strives to make policy decisions based on quantitative data; and

WHEREAS, the cost per black & white single sided printed paper (based on industry standards) is \$0.05; and

WHEREAS, Each Town Board member receives between 2,100 and 4,200 sheets of paper annually, and

WHEREAS, for every 16.67 reams of paper (8,333 sheets) a mature tree is consumed; and

WHEREAS, utilizing mobile computer/tablets for the distribution of meeting materials reduces the amount of staff time dedicated to assembling and delivering this material by 90%; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board being both cognizant of the cost and environmental impact of receiving paper packets desire to provide a computer/tablet to Town Supervisors for the purpose of conducting Town business.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Town Board in Greenville, Wisconsin does hereby declare that Town Supervisors & the Town Chairperson will receive a Town-issued mobile computer/tablet based on these conditions:

- Town Supervisors no longer receive paper packets for Town Board meetings.
- All mobile computer/tablet/tablets are deemed to have a useful life of three years.
- All mobile computer/tablet/tablets will be depreciated over a period of three years, using straight line depreciation.
- All mobile computer/tablet/tablets purchased will have a salvage value of \$100.
- After the mobile computer/tablet/tablet is fully depreciated, the Town Board member currently using it may purchase it at salvage value or return it to the Town.
- If a Town Board member wishes to purchase their mobile computer/tablet/tablet prior to full depreciation, they agree to pay the depreciated value.



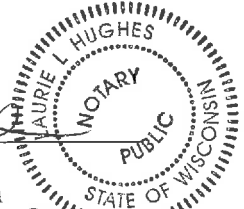


