7. ANNOUNCEMENTS

Pending final outcome of confidential personnel matters, Dave Tebo has been placed on Administrative Leave. During the interim, all tasks Community and Economic Development nature will be handled by the Town Administrator.

The Town Constable took several calls regarding the number of calls regarding pets from the fireworks at Immanuel Lutheran Church on October 21st. The Town will look into ways to communicate firework displays.

Future Topics:

Chairman Anderson has received a number of calls regarding refuse/yard waste burning. Discussion may be held in the future regarding a potential burning ordinance.

Town signage – there are a number of signs on outskirts of Town. Maintenance needs to be performed and discussion can be held during budget meetings.
