The storm windows are severely deteriorating, and they have launched a campaign to raise \$12,000 for replacement. Their fundraising efforts will be matched up to the \$12,000 amount. Donation information is listed on the form. A go fund me page has also been established to assist with their efforts. The Grange received a donation from the George and Ida Schaefer family for a sign. The Grange building turns 90 this year.
