

**MINUTES
SPECIAL TOWN MEETING
AUGUST 21, 2018**

1. CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at 6:31 p.m. by Town Chairperson Jack Anderson.

2. NEW BUSINESS:

- a. Pursuant to section 60.10 (2) (f) of the Wisconsin Statutes, to authorize the Town Board to purchase, lease or construct buildings for the use of the Town and to accept contributions of money, labor or space for this purpose.

Town Administrator, Joel Gregozeski, reviewed the State Statutes that govern Town Meetings and provided a brief presentation on the Fire and Safety Building Proposal.

Chairperson Anderson called for a motion on Resolution #40-18: A Grant of Authority to the Greenville Town Board for the Limited Purposes of Constructing and Equipping a new Fire and Safety Building.

Motion by Chuck Ossant, W6958 Parkview Dr., second by Ted Williams, W6152 Sherwood Point Dr., to approve Resolution 40-18, A Grant of Authority to the Greenville Town Board for the Limited Purposes of Constructing and Equipping a New Fire and Safety Building. Motion carried. AYE: 74 NAY: 1
