Questions were asked regarding Stormwater charges, fees associated with the Lin Stream Restoration, Incorporation as it relates to annual meetings and the traffic impact of the proposed Field of Dreams Sports Complex/Outdoor Recreation Facility on Hwy 96 and Julius Drive.

Jean Goffard presented the highlights of events held at the Grange including hosting a Civil War dance. The Grange is continuing to raise money for window replacement and will have a plant sale this spring to help with the efforts.
