

**TOWN OF GREENVILLE
ORDINANCE NO. 03-18
LIGHTING**

The Town Board of the Town of Greenville, Outagamie County does hereby ordain as follows:

Section § 320-220(E) of the Town of Greenville Code is hereby repealed and recreated as follows:


Lighting: Exterior lighting, whether freestanding or mounted on a building or structure, shall be down cast, shielded and oriented so as to not exceed the following light levels on adjacent properties: 0.05 horizontal foot-candles on residentially zoned property or non-residentially zoned property that has a residential use; 0.5 horizontal foot-candles on non-residentially zoned property; and 5 horizontal foot-candles on public road right-of-way; if light spills onto property across a public right-of-way the 0.05 and 0.5 horizontal foot-candle restrictions shall apply accordingly.

If this conflicts with any section within the Town of Greenville Municipal Code, this ordinance shall prevail.

This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication.
