

## **Resolution #42-18**

### **REQUESTING THE WISCONSIN DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION REDUCE SPEEDS ALONG STATE TRUNK HIGHWAY 76 IN THE TOWN OF GREENVILLE BETWEEN STATE TRUNK HIGHWAY 15 TO STATE TRUNK HIGHWAY 96.**

**WHEREAS**, the State Trunk Highway 76, between State Trunk Highway 15 and State Trunk Highway 96 serves as a major transportation corridor within the area of this population growth; and

**WHEREAS**, this section of State Trunk Highway 76 is a rural two-lane highway with a posted speed limit of 55 miles per hour; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Greenville has experienced substantial development and growth over the past twenty years; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Greenville has more than doubled in population since over the past twenty years from 5,538 residents in 1998 to 11,785 residents in 2018; and

**WHEREAS**, significant traffic volume and accidents have increased over the past twenty years along this section of State Trunk Highway 76; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Greenville Town Board feel that the 55 miles per hour speed limit on this section of State Trunk Highway 76 creates dangerous intersections for turning vehicles and pedestrians at: School Road, Lions Park, Greenridge Drive, Glennview Drive Sunnyvale Lane, due to the proximity of residential neighborhoods, a local middle and elementary school and a local YMCA; and


**WHEREAS**, the Greenville Town Board has adopted two previous resolutions supporting a posted speed limit reduction to 45 miles per hour; and


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Town Board of the Town of Greenville do ordain as follows:

1. Request the Wisconsin Department of Transportation reduce the current posted speed limit to 45 miles per hours for State Trunk Highway 76 between State Trunk Highway 15 to State Trunk Highway 96;
2. Request the Wisconsin Department of Transportation provide the necessary resources to the Outagamie County Sheriff's Department for the proper and consistent enforcement of this speed limit;
3. Authorize the Town Clerk to certify and forward copies of the Resolution to Governor Scott Walker, WisDOT Secretary of Transportation David Ross, Outagamie County Sheriff's Department and the offices of State Senator Roger Roth and State Representative David Murphy.
