

RESOLUTION #07-18

AUTHORIZING TOWN BOARD
TO ISSUE GENERAL OBLIGATION REFUNDING BONDS

WHEREAS, pursuant Section 60.10(2), Wisconsin Statutes, the electors of the Town of Greenville, Outagamie County, Wisconsin (the "Town") have the authority to issue directives or grant authority to the Town Board at an annual or special meeting;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 60.10(2)(d), Wisconsin Statutes, town electors may by resolution authorize the Town Board to issue general obligation refunding bonds in the manner and for the purposes provided by law;

WHEREAS, such grant of authority to the Town Board can be general and continuing and remain in effect until rescinded at a subsequent town meeting by a number of electors equal to or greater than the number of electors who voted for the original resolution; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the electors of the Town by a majority vote of the eligible electors voting at this town meeting assembled and voting, as follows:

The Town Board of the Town of Greenville is granted general and continuing authority to issue general obligation refunding bonds in the manner and for the purposes provided by law until such grant is rescinded or by the Annual Town Meeting in April 2020.


