

Park Commission Meeting Minutes

Tuesday, December 4, 2018 (normal November meeting)

Greenville Town Hall

7:00 P.M.

ATTENDANCE: Greg Roblee, Barb Schroeder, Ryan Paschke, and John Conrad. Absent: Tim James, Lou Judge, and Jim Beard; also present: Tony Nowak (Town Parks & Forestry), and Jack Anderson (Town Chairman).

Call to Order: at 7:00 pm by Greg Roblee.

Minutes: Correction to October 30 minutes: Sports Complex update – the November 27th presentation was also open to the public for input and recommendations. Approved by Ryan and John with correction.

Treasure Report: Not available.

Old Business

Light poles at sledding hill: Lights are up and functioning. 3 poles were installed – 1 on sledding hill and 2 by skate rink. A photo eye will turn the lights on at dusk and they are timed to turn off at 10 pm. A breaker will be used to turn the lights off when the rink or hill is not suitable for use. At the present time the lights at the skate rink are turned off till the ice rink is ready for use. Tony reported that the lights can be adjusted and that the light on the sledding hill may need to be adjusted downward more, but that cannot be done with snow on the hill.

New Business

Sports Complex master plan update: Chase Rettler from Rettler Corporation was in attendance to present the final concept for the master plan. Chase went through all the major features of the park. This concept was gathered from input meeting and email/Facebook comments. Tony reported that approx. 30-33 people attended that public input meeting and that emails and Facebook comments show a lot of positive comments. Along with the baseball and soccer fields the plan includes a splash pad and swimming pond, trails, and natural area.

This presentation was presented to the Sports Complex group prior to this meeting and they recommended approval of the concept to be forwarded to the Greenville Park Board.

Motion by Ryan to: ‘Approve the concept drawing and recommend to the Town Board that the Town adopt the final concept as presented.’ second by John. Vote: Yes - 4, No – 0, Passed. The plan will be forwarded to the Town Board for the December 17th meeting.

Other Business:

Community Park: Bleachers are installed at Diamond C. Concrete base is poured at Diamond A for the bleachers and will be poured in the spring at Diamond D. At the present time the base under Diamond C will remain stone till rain water flow can be addressed in the area. Sod has been laid in the area near the shelter to prevent rain run-off running through the playground chips and in that bleacher area.

Stream cleanup was done in the area behind the ball diamond and extended to north of Highway 15. Stones were removed that blocked natural flowage through the area. This flow will be monitored to see if flooding of the park has been decreased.

Lions Park: Damage to the sod that occurred with the Fall Fair Craft Fair will be fixed in spring. An attempt was made to roll the area this fall but it was so wet the roller almost got stuck.
