

**TOWN OF GREENVILLE
NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

Notice is hereby given that on Monday, November 12, 2018, a public hearing, as required by Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code"), will be held by the Town of Greenville, Wisconsin with respect to the proposed issuance by the Public Finance Authority of its revenue bonds in one or more series (the "Bonds"), in an amount not to exceed \$6,855,000. The hearing will commence at 6:00 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter can be heard, and will be held at Town Hall, W6860 Parkview Drive, Greenville, Wisconsin.

The Bonds are expected to be issued pursuant to Section 66.0304 of the Wisconsin Statutes, as amended, by the Public Finance Authority (the "Authority"), a commission organized under and pursuant to the provisions of Sections 66.0301, 66.0303 and 66.0304 of the Wisconsin Statutes, as amended.

The proceeds from the sale of the Bonds will be loaned to Immanuel Evangelical Lutheran Church, a religious society organized under Chapter 187 of the Wisconsin Statutes (the "Borrower"), to finance (i) eligible project costs relating to the renovation of the Borrower's existing school facilities located at W7265 School Road in the Town of Greenville, Outagamie County, State of Wisconsin and construction of an approximately 40,000 square foot addition to the school which will include additional classrooms, cafeteria, meeting space, and offices (the "Project") and (ii) costs of issuance.

The Bonds will be special limited obligations of the Authority payable solely from the loan repayments to be made by the Borrower to the Authority, and certain funds and accounts established by the Bond Agreement for the Bonds.

At the hearing, all persons will be afforded a reasonable opportunity to express their views, both orally and in writing, on the proposed Bonds and the location and nature of the Project proposed to be financed.
