Site Access

- Concept of right-of-way.
- Road connections east and west.
- Potential commercial to east.
 - 76 and Julius to west.
 - Conceptual lot layout to west and east.
- Highway 96 expansion, access with future discussion with D.O.T.

Site Features

- Aquatic features
 - Splash pad, swimming pond (Crystal Lake) (playground, splash pad, beach, integration)
 - Ashwaubomay Park – 6 to 8 lifeguards.
 - Splash/pond combination, pool cost prohibitive.

Transportation 233 guideline with 55 guideline, assuming plat of survey.

Airport overlay with county. Special exception permit.

Stormwater Management

- Route stormwater to the north and south.
- Prairie and landscape stormwater treatment.
- Prairie planting and educational opportunities.
- Connections are key.
- Roadway cross section.
 - Curbed/curbless?
 - Curb and gutter with breakouts (Bloomer).
- Stream restoration.
- Wetland information available.

Bridge, trails, passive recreation (north side).

Building Components

- Park maintenance building with restroom.



- Restroom, concession, storage for athletics.
- Sewer and water information from town.
- Electric and communication from south.
- 2-3 shelters with bathrooms and kitchenette (like at Lions). Stand alone.

Athletic Components

- ADA field programming.
- Water from splash pad to irrigation possible?

Unique Facilities

- Playground features (natural theme).
- Trail exercise equipment.
- Kearny, northeast, Yanney Park example.
 - Paddle boats, ponds, observation tower.
 - Interpretive features.
 - Grange (Agricultural Co-ops) social membership, social halls.
- 4 seasons use, cross-country, snowshoe.
- Disc golf.
- Dog run (2 acres).
- Bike trails (fat tire, single track).
