

Notice of Pending Application for Proposed Wetland Individual Permit

Joel Gregozeski (Town of Greenville Administrator), W6860 Parkview Drive, PO Box 60, Greenville, WI 54645 has applied to the Department of Natural Resources for a permit for wetland fill or disturbance near the Rat River. The project is located along Sections 15 and 16, Township 21 North, Range 16 East, Town of Greenville, Outagamie County. The proposed project will involve resurfacing, restoration and rehabilitation of 5,607 linear feet of Julius Drive. Proposed improvements will widen vehicle travel lanes from the existing 11 feet to the proposed 12 feet and establish 5-foot paved shoulder for bike lanes. A 1-foot gravel shoulder and safe side slopes will be provided along the project area. The proposed project will result in wetland impacts of 27,072 square feet (0.62 acres), classified as fresh wet meadow, which will be mitigated for in accordance with 281.36, Wis. Stats.

The Department will review the proposal provided by the applicant and any information from public comments and a public informational hearing, if requested. The Department will determine whether the proposal complies with ss. 1.11 and 281.36, 401 CWA, Stats., and ch. NR 150, Wis. Adm. Code, and ensure that the required mitigation meets the standards in s. 281.36(3r), Stats. if the project impacts wetlands.

The Department has made a tentative determination that it will issue the permit or contract for the proposed activity. Any person may submit comments and/or request a public informational hearing by emailing matthew.schaeve@wisconsin.gov or writing to Matt Schaeve, 2984 Shawano Avenue, Green Bay, WI 54313 by U.S. mail. If you are submitting general comments on the proposal, they must be emailed or postmarked within 30 days after the date this notice is published on the Department's website. If you are requesting a public informational hearing, the request must be emailed or postmarked within 20 days after the date this notice is published on the Department's website. A request for hearing must include the docket number or applicant name and specify the issues that the party desires to be addressed at the informational hearing.

If no hearing is requested, the Department may issue its decision without a hearing. If a public informational hearing is held, comments must be postmarked no later than 10 days following the date on which the hearing is completed. The final decision may be appealed as indicated in the decision document.
