THE ISSUANCE OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS


WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Greenville, Outagamie County, Wisconsin (the "Town"), has heretofore duly adopted a resolution entitled: "Initial Resolution Authorizing General Obligation Bonds in an Amount Not to Exceed \$6,500,000 for Constructing and Equipping a New Fire and Safety Building, (the "Initial Resolution"); and

WHEREAS, the Town Board deems it to be desirable and in the best interest of the Town to direct the Town Clerk to submit the question approved in the Initial Resolution to the electors for approval or rejection at the Partisan Primary election to be held on August 14, 2018.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Board of the Town of Greenville does hereby resolve and order as follows:
