**TOWN ROAD IMPROVEMENT DISCRETIONARY PROGRAM GRANT  
GREENWOOD ROAD PEDESTRIAN AND BICYCLE FACILITIES  
Town of Greenville, Outagamie County, Wisconsin**

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Greenville, Outagamie County is interested in acquiring a Town Road Discretionary Improvement Program (TRID) grant from the Wisconsin Department of Transportation for the purposes of reconstructing Greenwood Road from State Highway 15 to Parkview Drive; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Greenville Town Board desires to include bicycle and pedestrian facilities as part of the reconstruction of Greenwood Drive; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to s.84.01(35), Wis. Stats. the Town of Greenville Town Board must adopt an official resolution authorizing the establishment of those facilities as part of the improvement project; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Greenville is the only municipality in which the project will occur.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, the Town Board of the Town of Greenville does officially authorize the construction of bicycle and pedestrian facilities as part of the Greenwood Road reconstruction project with a Town Road Discretionary Improvement Program (TRID) grant from the Wisconsin Department of Transportation.


This Resolution shall take effect after passage and posting according to law.
