

Treenville Project Update September 21, 2020

2020 Contract A-20 Road Construction

Spring Road: North Road - Julius Drive

Project information: Rehabilitation of Spring Road between North Road and Julius Drive. Construction includes pulverizing the existing pavement, reshaping the base course to reestablish the roadway crown, and paving the new roadway surface. Cross culvert replacement and minor ditch cleaning will also be included as part of this project.

Anticipated Timeline: Construction May 2020 - August 2020

Road Closures, Vehicles & Traffic: While under construction, the roadway will be closed to through traffic. One lane of the roadway will be maintained for local traffic, but delays are likely due to construction equipment using the area. Be attentive of construction workers directing traffic through the construction zone.

Resident Access: Local resident access to and from your home will be maintained as much as possible during construction. If your driveway needs to be closed while construction is taking place, you will be notified by knocking on the door or by advanced email. Please contact the project inspector, Matt Smith if you require special access needs.

Communication: It is the intent of the Town to minimize the amount of disruption and inconvenience to the community during any construction process. If during normal work hours you feel something went unnoticed, or needs attention, please contact Matt Smith. As project inspector, they are most familiar with the daily operations of construction and can resolve many issues quickly.

If something happens after normal work hours that you feel requires immediate attention, please call 920-757-7276, and arrangements will be made to resolve the issue.

As always, in an emergency, please call 911.

Project Updates: Construction updates will be posted on the Town website bi-weekly, and when major changes will be occurring. If at any time you would like additional information, please contact Matt Smith.

Landscape Restoration: Property owners should continue to mow lawns and completing weed control in restored areas. Additionally, it is recommended to water newly seeded areas to ensure establishment of lawns.

General Notes:

- 1. The Town is coordinating with the mail carrier and garbage pickup to ensure deliveries and pickups will not be affected by construction.
- 2. Once the asphalt is paved, vehicle access to driveways will not be allowed for a few hours where possible. If you need special access, please contact the Project Inspector or the Town prior to the start of paving.
- 3. Please remove any irrigation, electric pet fences, landscaping, and other items within the Right-of-Way. This is your responsibility and not the Town's. If items are not removed prior to the Contractor completing work at your residence, they will be removed and disposed of by the Contractor.

Week of 9/21/20: Monitor project restoration for grass growth and erosion. Week of 9/28/20: Monitor project restoration for grass growth and erosion.
