



# **Town of Greenville**

## **Weed Control Policy**

*Effective: May 11, 2009*

The purpose of this policy is to set guidelines for the Weed Commissioner of the Town of Greenville to enforce the Weed Control Ordinance No. 38.

During each growing season, one (1) certified order to cut or destroy weeds shall be sent to the owner of the lot in violation. If within 10 days after receipt, the owner fails to comply with this order, the Town of Greenville shall destroy, remove or cut such vegetation in the most economical manner available. The owner will be billed for this service at the cost stated in the Town Fee Schedule. The Town Board may adjust this figure upward dependent on the cost of removal. If the full amount is not paid within 30 days of invoice, the expense will be added to the next tax roll. The Town thereafter has the ability to cut the said property without notice if the owner fails to continue maintenance. The fees for these services are also stated in the Town Fee Schedule.
