As Greenville continues to rapidly grow we need to look at other methods of water conservation. The motion made in 2001 to allow for discounted rates for summer watering and the filling of swimming pools has been rescinded by the Sanitary District Commissioners. As of October 6, 2015 there will no longer be a summer sprinkler credit. We are already running water dangerously low and are close to exceeding capacity. Therefore we had no choice but to remove watering forgiveness to preserve water. Many residents take advantage of the discounted rates for summer watering, using valuable drinking water to do miscellaneous projects around the yard. We are hoping that by discontinuing this process residents will be more cautious of how much water they are using outdoors during the summer months. We encourage more people to use rain barrels or even using sump pump water rather than using drinking water to water their lawns.

Note: We will still allow for the practice of establishing a new lawn with a sprinkler credit of 30,000 gallons and give approximately two months to establish a lawn with new home construction.
