It is licensed by the DNR. We are working on trying to find a way out of it. Any other meeting will be on the web site. It could be 10 -14 days out. If the building meets all codes, we have no right to turn it down. The Town would be in a law suit. Sue Behm is concerned that all the Board did not know about this. The letter from the Attorney was given to all Board members in June and that is when everyone knew about it.
