

47 Parking, Stopping and Standing

- (1) Additional parking limitations may be adopted by either resolution of the Town of Greenville Board of Supervisors or action of the Town Administrator, with copies of all such action to be kept with the Town Clerk for the Town of Greenville.
- (2) All night parking regulations
 - (a) No commercial vehicle shall be parked on any Town road/street, Town park or Town right-of-way between the hours of 12:00am and 6:00am. No commercial vehicle shall be parked on any Town road/street at any other times for a period longer than necessary to service or provide service or materials at the location where parked or standing, **except as authorized by the Town Chairman in writing, under unique circumstances where public safety is not impaired.**
 - (b) "Commercial Vehicles" shall be defined as any motor vehicle ordinarily used or designed for the delivery of goods, wares, merchandise, or material of any kind or for the transporting of people, supplies or tools in the conduct of any occupation, employment or business including all trucks and buses (school or charter) of any nature used as described herein.
 - (c) No construction equipment or containers shall be parked on any Town road/street, Town park or Town right-of-way between the hours of 12:00am and 6:00am.
 - (d) No person shall park his/her automobile or other vehicle on Town roads in the Town between the hours of 12:00am and 6:00am of each day from midnight of Nov. 15th through to midnight of March 31st of the subsequent year. In the event the owner, or operator, of such vehicles shall not attend to its removal, the Town Chairman or his designee is authorized to move such vehicles to some suitable location, at the owner's expense.
 - (e) These regulations shall be effective after passage, publication and after signs have been erected at or reasonably near the corporate limits of the Towns as provided in Sections 349.13, Wis.State Stats.
- (3) No person shall park any automobile or other vehicle on Town roads in the Town of Greenville that do not have a curb and gutter street section **and where the speed limit exceeds 30 MPH. The Town Chairman may also waive this section for special events.**
- (4) Penalties shall be set forth in the Town Fee Schedule, reference this code section.

Forfeitures / Fines:

Forfeitures / fines for parking, stopping and standing vary from a minimum of \$10 to a maximum of \$50 for each day of non-compliance and each occurrence. The forfeitures/fines are as follows:

<u>Notice of Violation</u>	<u>Owner/Operator</u>
First violation	\$10
Second violation within a twelve month of the Initial violation	\$25
Third and each and every subsequent violation Within the same time period	\$50

All payments shall be made to the Town Clerk

***Any of the above violations which causes the Town to come in and remove parked, stopped or standing vehicles shall incur all of the Towns cost plus any forfeiture/fine for that violation.**
