

Top 4 Recycling

"No No's"

Outagamie County Recycling has put together a list of the top 4 mistakes when placing recyclables at the curb:

- 1. Plastic Bags:** Plastic bags are the #1 problem. Please do not place your recyclables in plastic bags. Also, do not place plastic bags from grocery stores or retailers in your curbside recycling container. These plastic bags can be dropped off at numerous retailers to be recycled.

Re-useable containers with handles are recommended. The containers must be between 15 and 33 gallons and weigh no more than 50 lbs.

- 2. Late Set Outs:** Haulers start early. If you are a City of Appleton resident your recyclables should be placed at the curb the night before or by 4:30 am on your day of pick up.

If you live in any other part of the County, recyclables should be placed at the curb the night before or by 6:00 am on your day of pick up.

- 3. Curbside Placement:** Please separate your trash containers from your recyclable containers by at least 4 feet.
- 4. Plastic Motor Oil Bottles:** Motor oil containers are not recyclable. The oil residue contaminates the washing process when the plastics are recycled. Please throw in your trash.
